

Certificate in Biopharmaceutical Processing (Level 7)

The Biopharmaceutical industry is continuing to make strong contributions to the Irish economy. Its success generates a need for technically qualified personnel and offers significant career progression.

This award will focus on both Upstream and Downstream Processing. The programme is designed to attract experienced personnel who are seeking to upskill in this sector or avail of a CPD opportunity.

The special purpose award is delivered over 1 year, between 6.30pm - 9.30pm, one evening per week (Tuesdays).

The academic year comprises of two semesters, with each semester consisting of 13 weeks.

- ◆ Upstream Processing commencing in Sept 2017 (Semester 1)
- ◆ Downstream Processing commencing in Feb 2018 (Semester 2)

Practicals will be delivered in CIT and in the National Institute for Bioprocessing Research & Training (NIBRT), Dublin, in January 2018 (2 days). NIBRT replicates a state of the art industrial bio processing facility.

Single Module Certification

A special purpose award is awarded on successful completion of both modules. Each module is certified at level 7 in the National Qualifications Authority of Ireland (NQAI) framework.

Entry Requirements

Candidates preferably will have a BSc or BEng or equivalent to complete the programme. Higher Certificates in Engineering or Science (Level 6) will be considered.

Cost

Course fee is €1,650.
