





CIT Sports Facilities are among the finest in Ireland. These include an impressive 1,200 seater multipurpose stadium, sports hall, fully equipped gym and weights room, playing pitches, tennis court, international standard athletics track, a floodlight full size astro turf pitch which can be divided into four 5-a-side pitches and a walking/jogging track that encompasses the campus.

There is a vast range of sports clubs, ranging from Martial Arts and Watersports to Indoor Sports and Field Sports... you name it, CIT has it! Sports Day takes places in September in the Nexus Hall, when each club showcases its activities and recruits new members.

CIT's excellently prepared sports grounds and facilities played host to numerous competitions throughout the year including schools' and intercounty matches across various codes, International Cork City Sports Athletics Meet, GOAL Mile, Cork Primary School Sports and Special Olympic Munster competitions. CIT provides training facilities for a number of teams including the Cork GAA teams from Juvenille to Senior levels, Cork City Soccer and Munster Rugby Academy.

As well as catering for the competitive athlete, CIT's Sports Clubs places a big emphasis on participation and fun and this is reflected in the growing numbers who take part. The Sports Office organise and coordinates a number of physical activity classes and health initiatives such as a Student & Staff Fun Run/Walk, HIIT, Circuit Training, Indoor Cycling, Pilates, and Yoga.
