



CIT/ CORK GOLF CLUB SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME 2017-2018

Criteria of Eligibility

To apply for the CIT/ Cork Golf Club Scholarship programme, you must fulfill the criteria of eligibility of CIT Sports Scholarships programme and in addition the criteria listed below by Cork Golf Club:

- Applications will be considered from current full time students of Cork Institute of Technology.
- Applicants must compete at or have the potential to compete for Cork Golf Club at Local, National and Inter-Provincial Level.
- Successful candidates will compete in accordance with Cork Golf club rules in relation to junior members.
- Successful scholarship recipients are ambassadors of the Cork Institute of Technology and Cork Golf Club and should conduct themselves accordingly.

Programme Outline

• This Scholarship applies to 2 golfers from CIT (1 male and 1 female) starting in 2017 for a 4 year trial period i.e. maximum of 8 golfers on scholarship in year 4.

The Scholarship will offered at our Awards Ceremony during Semester 1 and will continue for a maximum of 4 years or when the each student's academic year ends.

- Successful candidates will receive coaching, kit, range balls and food credit from Cork Golf Club.
- Membership to junior ranks can follow after the end of the Scholarship but the formal application process will still apply

Cork Golf Club Scholarship Application

Golfers that wish to be considered for the Cork Golf Club Scholarship award for the 2017-2018 academic year, must complete a CIT Scholarship Application form along with section A and B below and return completed Applications to the Sport Office, Cork Institute of Technology, Bishopstown, Cork.

The closing date for receipt of application forms for the Cork Golf Club Scholarship award is **Thursday 21st of September 2017**

Short listed applicants will be invited to attend an interview with Cork Golf Club and CIT representatives. The panel will consider the applicants current level of performance to include frequency and duration of achievement, potential in your sport and the possible contribution to sport at CIT. The Panel will also consider the high performance structure in your sport. If successful at interview, athletes will be offered a conditional Golf Scholarship Award at our awards ceremony in Semester 1.
