

## **CIT 2018 Guideline DARE Reduced places available**

This document gives an indication of the 2018 reduced points places in CIT that may be available to DARE eligible applicants. **CIT has a guideline quota of 5% of places on reduced points in all undergraduate programmes.**

Please note that the numbers of DARE places on individual courses below are guideline numbers. They are based on this quota and on the 2017/18 numbers for each course.



### **To be considered for a CIT DARE reduced points place:**

- Eligible DARE applicants must meet the minimum requirements of a course. The CIT website: [www.cit.ie/courses](http://www.cit.ie/courses) has the minimum requirements for all courses.
- Applicants are then considered for places when they are within a 50 point band below the cut-off point when the DARE offers are made through the CAO.
- Applicants with sensory disabilities (such as visual or hearing loss) and physical disabilities will be prioritised when allocating DARE reduced points places.

\* The points for these courses are calculated from a combination of two scores – a score given for an entrance test, audition, or portfolio (there is a minimum score that applicants must meet) and the applicant’s Leaving Certificate points. Please note that when making DARE offers for these courses that **CIT only considers a reduction for the Leaving Certificate points portion** and applicants must meet the minimum requirements for these courses.
