

# CIT Disability Support Service Registration Information 2017/18

If you need any supports for your lectures or exams when you are at CIT because of your learning difference, health condition or disability you will need to register with the CIT Disability Support Service (DSS).

## How to register with the DSS

## **STEP 1** Fill out online Registration form:

Please fill out the online registration form available at <a href="www.mycit.ie/dss">www.mycit.ie/dss</a> at the end of August. The link will also be sent to new students' myCIT email in the first week of Semester 1 (mid September). Make sure to click 'Submit'.

## **STEP 2** Provide documents:

- Email your documents to the DSS at <u>dss@cit.ie</u> or give/post a photocopy of your documents with evidence/diagnosis of your learning difference, health condition or disability to the DSS, based in the Access Service (ground floor Student Centre, CIT, Bishopstown open 8.30am 4.30pm).
- Please give us as much information as possible including full diagnosis. Please see our webpage for more information about documents needed:

The DSS can get copies of your documents if you sent them to the CAO/DARE in 2017.
 We do not need another copy unless you have new or updated information.


# STEP 3 Go to DSS needs assessment meeting:

- To fully register with the DSS you must go to a needs assessment meeting with one of the DSS staff which confirm your supports. This may be one-to-one or in a small group. The DSS will only meet you once we have your documents.
- We will email your myCIT email to arrange a meeting with you. Please note that you may need to wait a few weeks to hear about your meeting in September or October.

## **Exam Supports deadlines**

In order to confirm the exam supports you are entitled to, you <u>must</u> register fully with the DSS (includes going to a meeting) by these dates:

Semester 1 exams:	Friday 27 <sup>th</sup> October 2017
Semester 2 exams:	Friday 16 <sup>th</sup> March 2018
Repeat/August exams:	Friday 6 <sup>th</sup> July 2018


