Examples of Documents acceptable for evidence of having lived in an Eu country

1. Original letter from a **school** attended - dated, stamped and signed by a school official. Dates *from* and *to* clearly indicated.
2. Original letter from a **college** attended - dated, stamped and signed by a college official. Dates *from* and *to* clearly indicated.
3. Original letter from a place of **work** – dated, stamped and signed by an official there. Dates *from* and *to* clearly indicated.
4. A sworn Affidavit from a **solicitor** in Ireland confirming residency in Ireland for specific dates (from and to). The letter must be on official headed paper from the solicitor’s office, and the phone number and solicitor’s name and address clearly visible. Your name and passport number to be noted in the contents. Dated and stamped by solicitor’s office.

Note: do not submit bank statements, or bills.

*The Admissions office reserves the right to request further documentation to confirm residency status.
