Application

Application for this course is strictly through the CAO system.

Assessment Procedure:

Candidates must attend an assessment day in the CIT Cork School of Music, Union Quay, Cork. A points score out of a maximum of 600 will be assigned on the basis of this assessment. This is added to the candidate's Leaving Cert points score and the CAO then use the resulting total out of 1200 to rank all eligible candidates and offer places on the course

The Entrance Test has 2 parts:

- Group Drama Workshop (40%)
- Audition & Interview (60%)

Group Drama Workshop

Each candidate participates in a group drama workshop, lasting 45 minutes. Candidates will be asked to follow a series of directions and to respond to a range of suggestions and stimuli provided by the external workshop facilitator. Candidates' contributions in the workshop will be observed and assessed by staff members. Candidates are encouraged to participate as freely and as spontaneously as possible. Please ensure you wear comfortable and appropriate clothing - i.e. clothing that will allow for free and flexible movement. You must be prepared to work in bare feet.

Audition & Interview

Candidates must prepare a three- to four-minute monologue from a published play of their choice, which they will perform within an individual audition/interview. This monologue should not be from a film script. As part of the audition/interview. applicants will be given the opportunity to discuss their audition piece, their interest in Theatre & Drama studies, and their experience within the area to date.
