Science Without Borders Entry Requirements

For Call 3 (September 2015 Entry)

- Applicants must achieve the English language proficiency standards as set out in Language Requirements (see below)
- Applicants should have achieved an average of 60% or higher in most recent set of major examinations (GPA of 3.0/5.0 or GPA of 6.0/10.0)
- Alignment between studies completed to date by the applicant and the area of interest in CIT should be strong

Documentation Required when applying to CIT:

- 1) Your University Transcript
- 2) Your English Language test results
- 3) Copy of the identification page on your passport
- 4) An academic letter of reference from a member of faculty at your home University (optional)
- 5) For Architecture students, a portfolio is not required, but if you have one, please do include it in your application

English Language Entry Requirements for direct academic entry to CIT:

- iBT - minimum 79
- IELTS - minimum 6.5
- ITP not acceptable for direct entry, PSE required! See below.

I don't meet the above requirements - Can I still apply?

Yes! Applicants presenting for up to 8 weeks pre-sessional English (PSE) tuition (from July to early September 2015 inclusive) must meet our minimum English language proficiency entry requirements, as follows:

- iBT - minimum 69
- ITP - minimum 525
- IELTS - minimum 6.0

Note: TOEFL ITP is not accepted by CIT for direct entry into undergraduate programmes. TOEFL ITP scores are only accepted for candidates presenting for pre-sessional English classes.

Following successful completion of 8 weeks PSE tuition, candidates can proceed directly into undergraduate study at CIT in September 2015.
