In addition to the general QQI entry arrangement through the CAO, MTU Cork Campus has an admissions scheme called the Cork Colleges Progression Scheme (CCPS) for the admission of students who successfully complete QQI courses in our linked Further Education (FE) colleges in Cork.

Under CCPS, a number of courses in MTU Cork Campus are linked to certain courses in the FE colleges. MTU Cork Campus reserves a number of places on these linked courses for applicants who achieve specified levels and other requirements in their QQI award.

# Applicants to MTU Cork Campus Year 1 and Year 2

**Students undertaking a full QQI level 5 course** who are applying for entry into Year 1 will be made offers in CAO Round 0 on QQI quota basis. Specific entry criteria for QQI applicants is listed on [www.cao.ie/qqi](http://www.cao.ie/qqi)

**Students undertaking a full QQI level 6 course** who are applying for entry into Year 2 will be reviewed and made offers through the CAO based on the criteria highlighted in the CCPS course links document on [www.cit.ie/ccps](http://www.cit.ie/ccps)

It is strongly advised that students with a QQI level 6 award apply for entry to both year one and year two.

During CAO Round 1 and subsequent CAO rounds, CCPS applicants may still receive an offer, subject to place availability.

**\*Please note there is no entry to year 2 of Social Care Work (CR031)**



All applicants must have applied to MTU Cork Campus through the CAO by 1 February 2021. Late applications will be accepted up to 1 May 2021 via [www.cao.ie](http://www.cao.ie) except for restricted courses.

Applicants to year one and/or year two need to complete the online CCPS application by 1 May 2021 via [www.cit.ie/ccps](http://www.cit.ie/ccps)
